Mr. Scott has more than 30 years of experience providing management, scientific, and technical consulting services, including 25 years supporting private and public sector clients under a variety of technical assistance, emergency response, emergency management, planning, and training and exercise programs. He has held various positions throughout his career, including contract manager, project manager, emergency preparedness and response coordinator, technical advisor, and quality assurance/quality control coordinator.

Mr. Scott is presently and concurrently serving as Tetra Tech's Program Manager for the USEPA Region 5 Superfund Technical Assistance and Response Team (START) contract, a 5-year contract valued at approximately \$48M and the USEPA Environmental Response Team (ERT) Environment Response Training Program (ERTP) contract, a 5-year contract valued at approximately \$17MM. As Program Manager for these two contracts, Mr. Scott is responsible for ensuring compliance with the terms of task orders and work assignments; cost control, monitoring work schedules, budgets, and developing/approving cost estimates; providing monthly status reports on accomplishments, budgets and contract issues; implementation of Health and Safety policy and procedures to ensure field compliance; and overseeing multi-disciplinary teams made of internal and subcontracted staff resources.

Mr. Scott has responded to and/or directed more than 100 emergency response actions, including the anthrax and ricin responses in Washington, D.C., the terrorist attack on the Pentagon on September 11, 2001, and numerous oil spills, during which he lead multi-disciplined teams of responders. Mr. Scott has also conducted more than 150 site assessments or inspections and has served as project manager on more than 50 U.S. EPA removal and remedial actions. He is a five time marathoner, including Boston, triathlete and PADI certified SCUBA diver.
